CRANBERRY-OATMEAL COOKIES

Ingredients:

1 1/2 c. flour 1 lg. egg, beaten
 1 tsp. baking soda 1 tsp. vanilla
 1 tsp. Cinnamon 1-1/2 c. rolled oats
 1 c. butter, softened 1 c. sweetened, dried, cranberries
 1/2 c. sugar

Directions:

Sift together flour, baking soda, and cinnamon. Set aside. Cream butter and sugars until fluffy, about 3 minutes. Mix beaten egg in thoroughly, then stir in vanilla. Add dry mixture. Mix in oatmeal and then dried cranberries. Give it a final mixing. Refrigerate, covered, for 1 hour. Preheat the oven to 350 degrees. Grease a cookie sheet, allowing space for cookies to spread. Bake for 10 minutes, or until set. Makes about 5 dozen cookies.
