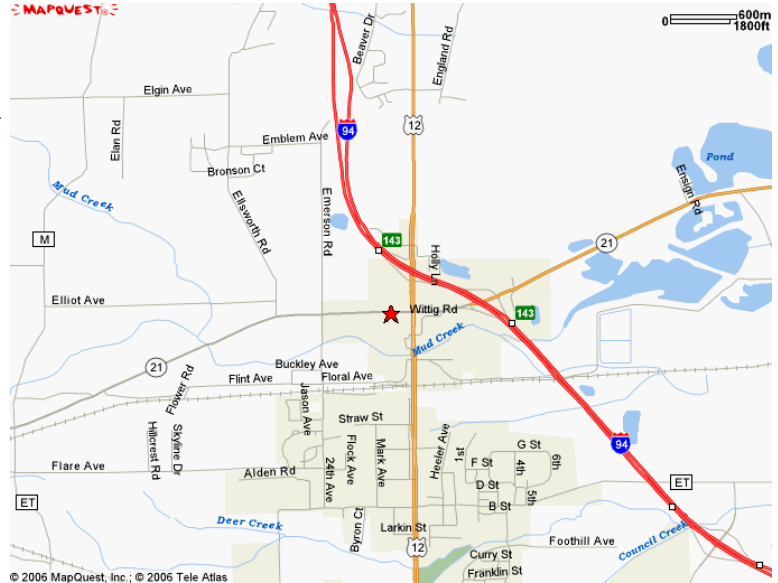

Featured Recipe - Rustic Apple Cranberry



Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.
Matthew 5:16

Ingredients:

- 1 crust from 15-ounce package of refrigerated pie crusts
- 1 21-ounce can apple pie filling
- 1 cup Ocean Spray® Fresh or Frozen Cranberries, chopped
- 1/4 cup chopped walnuts, optional
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon sugar

Directions:

Preheat oven to 400°F. Unwrap pie crust; press seams together firmly. Place in a 9-inch pie plate. Combine all ingredients, except sugar, in medium mixing bowl; mix well. Spoon fruit mixture into pastry-lined plate. Fold edges of pastry over fruit, pleating so crust lies flat. Sprinkle sugar over crust. Bake 15 minutes. Reduce oven temperature to 350°F. Bake for 40 to 45 minutes or until fruit is bubbly and crust is golden brown.

Makes 8 servings.

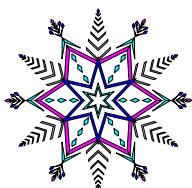
