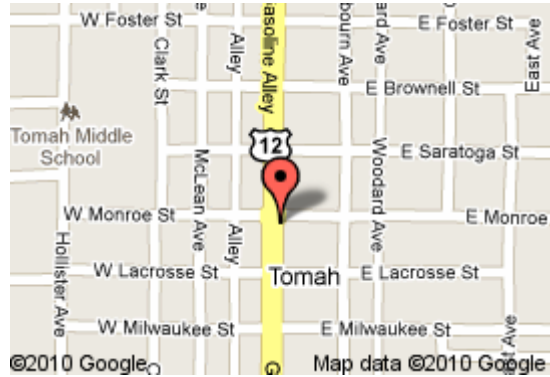

CHICKEN with CRANBERRY SAUCE

Ingredients:

- 1 chicken, cut up
- 1 c. Russian dressing with honey
- 1 pkg. Dry onion soup mix
- 1 16 oz. can whole cranberry sauce

Directions:

Mix last 3 ingredients. Pour over chicken and marinate for 24 hours. DO NOT DRAIN. Bake at 300 degrees for 1-1/2 hours or until the chicken is done, stirring glaze and spooning over chicken once or twice. Serve chicken and glaze on a platter with hot, cooked rice if desired.
